## Background and experience

### Brief **PRESENTATION** of the organization

"Development center Pangeya Ultima" is the Ukrainian non-governmental, non-profit organization (est. 2012) composed of youth, youth workers and third sector experts. Main mission statement: Fostering intercultural dialogue, creation of opportunities for personal development and emancipation of people, facilitation of sustainable development of communities.

Programs of the NGO encompass a range of topics the most active of which are the promotion of active citizenship, self-development of people and community development, intercultural dialogue and peace-building, media and communication, arts and culture, entrepreneurship stimulation (especially socially-inclined forms of entrepreneurship) and tourism development, environmental protection and tackling ecologic issues, etc.

The activities of the NGO are often based on non-formal education and utilization of international mobility programs. With this the organization pursues its fundamental mission – facilitation of the intercultural dialogue. This is enshrined in the name concept of the organization. The NGO provides intercultural learning and encourages participation in the international context among its target groups, particularly promotes European awareness.

The NGO acts a lot on the local level and state levels, has a considerable profile of international activities. Locally the NGO operates as a center of mobility, non-formal education and self-development, its participants uncover their individual potential and help exploit the potential of own communities for the sake of sustainable development and democratic transformation in society.

The NGO promotes active cooperation and has forged numerous and strong partnerships with other CSOs, educational establishments, international organizations, public bodies and businesses.

### What is the experience of **KEY PEOPLE** engaged?

Our organization counts a couple of dozens of members, adding that we have scores of followers and visitors from among the local community. The most important decisions in the organization are taken by the elected Council of organization. The organization has an Administrational wing with an executive department headed by the operational manager. It facilitates the Council in its work and the Programs wing with project workgroups. The organization has coordinators and youth workers with good profile and experience in project design and management, third sector activism, community engagement, education and training.

***EXPERTISE with the mobility Programmes and with youth work practices***

Our organization is active with non-formal education and volunteering mobility programmes such as Youth-in-Action, European Voluntary Service, Erasmus+ Youth and European Solidarity Corps for around a decade now. We have had successful experience of organizing numerous youth-oriented projects in consortiums with organizations from all over Europe and other Regions of the world. We are preparing youth groups from among our local target beneficiaries among whom are lot of youth with fewer opportunities (e.g. we work with the topic of youth empowerment in rural areas, internally displaced people) for short-term mobility projects and to participate in ESC, we are developing local communities around our local programs and as well we train youth workers through their participation in joint youth workers mobility projects with our partners.

We have had experience of local hosting and organizing **Key Action 1** mobility projects in Ukraine and together with our partners in different countries and even continents: youth exchanges, training courses, study visits, seminars. We have working project concepts with approved performance indicators that can serve our joint collaboration purposes towards our target groups both in Ukraine and in other countries. We are searching for long-term compatible and mutually beneficial partnerships, therefore those organization that acquire **Erasmus Accreditation in the field of Youth** can trust our sustainability and consistent approach to cooperation. So we welcome you to collaboration over **Mobility of Learners and Staff** and over **Youth Participation Activities** – our young beneficiaries and youth workers will certainly make a difference in their communities! Our organization has been a partner on many occasions in the **Key Action 2 Capacity Building** and **Strategic Partnership** projects in the Erasmus+ 2014-2020. We have successfully coordinated Capacity Building cooperation in frames of the Eastern Partnership Youth Window ourselves and are looking for another chance of applying for this opportunity once the call will become available through European Neighborhood financial mechanisms. In the new Erasmus+ 2021-2027 program there's a good chance for our collaboration exactly under the **Key Action 2 Cooperation Among Organizations and Institutions – Capacity Building in the Field of Youth** strand as it supports joint projects of organizations from the Programme and Partner countries. Besides that, with our tailored approach to collaboration and innovative deep community projects we certainly can bring an ADDED VALUE for inviting us as to become partners in your **Cooperation Partnerships** and **Forward-looking projects of Key Action 2**.

One of the strongest experience of our organization is the work with the long-term volunteering programs such as **European Solidarity Corps**. We are one of the most active support and hosting organizations in this direction in Ukraine so far all thanks to our community-building approach. You can expect participants in your ESC placements rigorously prepared (visa, insurance, travel advice) and oriented according to ESC principles. We are organizing conceptual and program-rich ESC placements in Vinnytsia ourselves (e.g. an amateur media production community) and value every ESC participant as our own indispensable part of the team. We are the first organization in Ukraine to receive **ESC Quality Label** with a possibility to host volunteers in the rural community – there, in a small Ukrainian village of Stina we develop a center of experiential education and sustainable development. So, if your participants want a UNIQUE IMMERSION IN THE UKRAINIAN AUTHENTIC CULTURE – you know who to ask to become your hosting ESC partner.

In our PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITY we orientate ourselves towards the same priorities as pursued by the Erasmus Plus programme 2021-2027. We practice **Inclusive Approach** while working with our beneficiaries from the rural areas, internally displaced people, unemployed and youth outside of the training system, people with disabilities, young parents, local ethnic minorities, younger children, people with social challenges and etc. Our organization understands the importance of the **Digital Transformation** as a way to adapt to current global challenges and we implement a lot of digital youth work activities. Our organization is one among the vanguard exploring alternative development built on value-based community building and sustainable development as a way to tackle the negative consequences of the climate change – we have initiated with our partners a center of sustainable development and experiential education in one of the authentic rural communities in Ukraine (ECO-CENTER STINA) and we see this as an answer to global climate-related and environmental/social justice issue. With this program and through harnessing our environmental education expertise we work actively in direction of **Environment and fight against climate change**. Our specific interest is giving voice to our target groups and empowerment of people to actively **Participate in the Democratic life**. This has an especially visible results in the same ECO-CENTER STINA community program and other community building and leadership programs we create for our beneficiaries.

We put a special attention to IMPORTANT FEATURES of the Erasmus+ programme:

**Protection, health and safety** – our participants are rigorously instructed and advised before any activity or mobility, we get a proper insurance, conceive a travel itinerary, engage parents or guardians (when needed), prepare project formal documentation and perform any other necessary action to work responsibly with our beneficiaries.

We help and support participants in their communication with peers, partners or with the third parties. **Multilingualism** is one of the principles we stands on and we have appropriate human resources (staff, interpreters, tutors) supporting participants of mobility projects in Ukraine.

We understand the need for strong visibility and **International Dissemination** of the results which gives proper credit not only to the often intensive and difficult job youth workers and managers of partner organizations are doing in every project but as well acknowledges the support of the Erasmus+ and ESC programs. We have a promotional and communication strategy on the place, utilize visual identities, realize follow-up visibility events, collect personal feedbacks and stories for our blogs from the participants, apply proper qualitative and quantitative indicators for assessments and etc. Our organization has a big followers community on our social media, we work responsibly with our web presence in other channels and engage local journalists to our actions to give additional visibility on the regional level. For it we have studied our target groups and shaped out the tailored messaging strategy to **Maximise impact from the realized results**.

Our organization fights for the **Recognition and Validation of Skills and Qualifications** acquired by our participants through non-formal education projects and we utilize European adopted tools as Youthpass, Europass but also we implement our author Certificate of Experience Recognition that we issue to participants of our local non-formal education projects.

Our organization promotes **Open Access** to intellectual outputs and methodological materials produced through partnership projects – all to reinforce the influence of non-formal education sectors in Europe.



Our organization approaches in a structured and responsible manner all of the stages of the project design and management. We have high cooperation standards and check for quality indicators of our performance at all **PLANNING – PREPRATION – IMPLEMENTATION – FOLLOW-UP** levels. The most important principles that we cultivate and base every cooperation are: open dialogue, mutual support, transparency, accountability and consistency.

At the stage of **Planning** we are actively realizing project needs assessments, define learning outcomes, activity formats, jointly with our partners develop work programs and timely plan the schedules of activities, we plan the communication strategy and eventual sustainability of the project. During the **Preparation** phase we responsibly realize all practical arrangements depending on our roles in the consortium, we select relevant participants, set up necessary agreements with engaged parties and engage other interested in our project stakeholders, instruct and practically support participants in their mobility, etc. During the **Implementation** we efficiently divide tasks and responsibilities, provide on-going visibility to actions, constantly monitor the process and get feedback from the participants, we create space for on-going reflection of the participants and managers and adapt to changing environment, when necessary we apply contingency strategies in constant accord with our partners. During the **Follow-up** we jointly evaluate with our partners realized activities, assess impact through qualitative and quantitative indicators, validate experiences of involved individuals, realize a targeted dissemination strategy, exploit project outputs together with our partners and launch the project sustainability scenarios.

### **TARGET GROUPS**, their needs and how we reach them

Our organization targets both – general group of people and especially youth in communities where we are active so as the **(YOUNG) PEOPLE WITH FEWER OPPORTUNITIES**. We are active in three different social areas – in urban community of Vinnytsia city (circa. Half a million inhabitants) where our target groups represent people with very diverse backgrounds and often among them such categories as: internally displaced people, people with disabilities, unemployed and those who dropped out from the education system, seniors, ethnic minorities. We are very active with our work with the rural communities and rural target groups. Especially in the two rural territorial communities in the region of Vinnytsia. In one territorial community we are working in the Stina village over a program called “Eco-Center Stina” and there we target local youths and people from the countryside. These youngsters often have a very limited or no access to non-formal education, the unemployment rate here is very high and external emigration takes place constantly, besides that the local school does not provide proper linguistic preparation for the pupils though they are compelled to make a foreign languages testing upon their graduation. Majority of people inhabiting this community are engaged in personal farming and intercultural interaction is something which is very scarce in these territories.

The organization has experience of local, regional and national call campaigns and if we cannot find participants among the affiliated people/youth or in the local communities we connect more with our partners from the civil sector or state partners, as well we have ties with the outlets providing information to youth on educational opportunities. Our criteria for selection are based on inclusion, free access, gender balance, motivation-oriented approach, we are trying to build long-term ties with every our participant and stimulate their follow-up activities.

Which kind of **PREPARATION** we offer to participants

**Volunteering projects:** The participants will undergo a Pre-Departure Preparation that will consist of theoretic, moral and practical support. They are provided with info-kits, other materials on the Erasmus Plus and European Solidarity Corps programmes. Formal moments will be solved with the involvement of the local ESC coordinator: visa, travelling itinerary, insurances, etc. We have experience of soliciting visas for participants taking part in the most of European countries. The volunteer will be prepared in subjects relating to the intercultural awareness, open-mindedness, conflict resolution, empowerment, time-management, knowledge of the Programme, personal financial management and problem solving. The volunteer will meet with former EVS/ESC volunteers from the Vinnytsia community to get additional inspiration and practical support.

**Short-term youth mobilities:** The groups of participants will jointly be prepared by group leaders or other representatives of the organization. Our group leaders are responsible youth workers with the experience of leading youth-oriented projects and we have an internal support system for youth workers. Practical questions will be solved by the organization, common itineraries will be designed. The participants will be briefed on intercultural awareness, will be equipped with other project-specific information (info-packs, information about the hosting side, etc.). For us the safety and well-being of the participants is the most important thing so they will be properly insured, briefed and assisted in seeking possible health-related support. Whenever needed for youth under 16 years old their parents or the wards will be engaged in the preparation and consultation stage. The participants will be guided into follow-up ideas and explained how they could use the attitudes and knowledge gained on after the project finishes.

**Mobilities of youth workers:** Our youth workers are selected and engaged on the principles of responsibility, motivation and dedication to the sector of youth work. We have high expectations to such participant in our future collaboration so we never select occasional visitors or “tourists”. With the youth workers we develop their own interests and prioritize their learning benefit. Our youth workers are selected on the principles of the good-will, gender balance, promising follow-up engagement and required linguistic competency.

### **PROJECT PROPOSALS WRITING**

Our organization is happy to contribute its conceptual and intellectual input into planning and project design of the joint collaborative partnerships. In this way we have had multiple and successful experiences of writing common proposals with our partners for Key Action 1, 2, EVS and ESC calls. We are glad to work on the elaboration of merged and mutually benefiting project designs and prioritize the impactful and long-term partnerships in frames of transformative and sustainable project concepts.

Our project writers have a vast experience of working with **eForms**, related documentation and required procedures. We are working on mutually comfortable financial terms and are very active with the side fund-raising. Our organization has a wide network of potential partners that we are eager to offer into our joint project consortiums depending on the topic of the project, relevance or any sort of other required expertise.
